
Next to the EBMT activity survey we conduct the Cellular Therapy Activity Survey on Cell or Engineered Tissue Transplants. The data are collected on cellular therapies such as MSC, HSC for regenerative purposes etc. If you have performed such therapies please report them in Table 3 of the EBMT Activity survey and in addition on the more detailed survey on Cellular Therapies. If you do not perform these transplants yourself please pass it on to any other department in your centre.

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If you do not have any data to report to the 2011 survey, please let us know by returning this letter, indicating the reason.
